1st Annual Meet and Eat Cheese and Apple Pie Run hosted by the ZONC North Valley Area Representatives Team. Ready to have a great day, travel country roads and even eat your cheese and pie as well?

Hungry for some very renown and fantastic Gouda Cheese made in a local factory? Then, Oakdale Cheese Factory is just the place to visit. See how the cheese is actually made from milk and turned into rounds of pristine cheese. Having the secrets of this historic process tucked away in their small country-side location, the Oakdale Cheese factory is a natural part of a Z Run in the foothills of the Sierras. The tour of the facility is accompanied by a serious taste testing and then you have the opportunity to buy from a multitude of cheese selections.

Not to be challenged, the point of this run is to venture to Covers Apple Ranch, where you can take a train ride through the orchards, pet friendly farm animals and exclusively step back in time and see an operating apple ranch. Having survived over 4 decades, this site offers a multitude of freshly baked goods including their renown "Mile High Apple Pie". Also featured are their various preserves and freshly made Juices. If you have the tastes for a specialty Pie, you can call ahead and order yours before you get there. Having a cafe as well, you can have lunch there from a wide variety of freshly made foods and sandwiches.

I would like to thank all Members who attended our General Board meeting at Melo's Pizza and Pasta in Livermore, CA on Saturday, April 14, 2012. We had a long and productive meeting and we finalized some details regarding our Annual Car Show at the Brisbane Marina on July 28, 2012.

Fees for our Annual Car Show at the Brisbane Marina will be: \$15.00 for Members, who pre register and \$25.00 for non-members who pre register. Day of the event registration will be \$30.00 for all with no discount for Members. The deadline for pre registration is July 7, 2012 and registration forms may be found at our web site, **ZONC.org**, under Event Registration where you can register online and pay your fees thru Pay Pal. Event T-shirts may also be pre ordered, as there will be a limited number on hand at the show.

This year we will have two classes that cars will compete in, Stock and Modified. Our guidelines for cars in the Stock class shall be: Cars that have all original "stock" parts except for the following replacements: 1) tinted windows, wheels and tires, 2) audio sound system, and 3) exhaust systems. These are the most common parts that are replaced due to age and wear and tear. Any other modifications or upgrades will be judged in the Modified classification. 
