2nd Annual Meat and Cheese & Apple Pie Run

On **Saturday, May 4, 2013** the 2ND ANNUAL MEAT AND CHEESE & APPLE PIE RUN hosted by the ZONC North Valley Area Representatives Team will take place. Be ready to have a great day, travel country roads and even have the opportunity to eat your cheese and pie as well.

Hungry for some very renown and fantastic Gouda Cheese made in a local factory, then Oakdale Cheese Factory is just the place to visit. See how the cheese is actually made from milk and turned into rounds of pristine cheese. Having the secrets of this historic process tucked away in their small countryside location, the Oakdale Cheese Factory is a natural part of a Z Run in the foothills of the Sierras. Having the tour of the facility is accompanied by a serious taste testing and the opportunity to buy from a multitude of cheese selections.

Not to be challenged, the point of this run is to venture up to just outside in the foothills of the Sierra Mountains to the historical COVERS APPLE RANCH. Here you can take a train ride through the orchards, pet friendly farm animals and exclusively step back in time and see an operating apple ranch. Having survived over 4 decades, this site offers a multitude of freshly baked goods to include their renown "Mile High Apple Pie". Also featured are their various preserves and flowing freshly made Juices. If you have the tastes for a specialty Pie, you can call ahead and order yours before you get there. Having a cafe as well, you can have lunch there as well from a wide variety of freshly made foods and sandwiches.

We will be meeting at the Junction of Highway 120 and 99 at the Uniroyal gas station at 0900-0930. Wendy's is right behind the gas station and you will see me with the ZONC banner setup by my Pearl White 350Z. From there, we will travel easterly along the country roads until we reach the outskirts of Oakdale. Here you will see the Cheese Factory on your left.

Spending about an hour there, we will head on to Covers on Hwy 108/120 and towards the historic township of Sonora. We do pass the old Indian Traders Shop and can stop there to see some very interesting antiques, turquoise jewelry, blankets and many other buyable collectibles. This route takes you along some very picturesque roads and scenery. Arriving at the Sonora

Junction, we head off towards Tuolumne on Tuolumne Road and in about 10 minutes, we will arrive at Covers Apple Ranch. Here, you will have your taste buds teased and pleased. The entire distance is only 65 miles, one-way.

Having lunch at Covers, we will return back towards Manteca and subsequently on our different ways to home again. Some of the sights we will be passing by include; Indian Reservation Arts and crafts, Historic Jamestown, Historic Jamestown Train yard and even the Black Oak Casino, should you feel lucky. Thirty-three cars including Z's, G's, a GT-R, Datsun Roadster and a Skyline accompanied by 52 people met at Panera Bread in Walnut Creek on a cool March 9 Saturday morning for the seventh annual Contra Costa Cruise. Amazingly, participants came from as far as Fresno and Ukiah, and even from Fernley, Nevada!

Starting on city streets, the Cruise took us on back roads in Contra Costa, Alameda and San Joaquin Counties. After heading east through Concord and Clayton, everyone caught up at Round Valley Regional Park behind Mt. Diablo and filled the corner parking lot. Beneath beautiful blue skies and the backdrop of spring green hills, the massive gathering of bright shiny sports cars was a fantastic sight to behold.





From the Park, we headed to Vasco Road where we turned south, crossing the foothills and descending to the Livermore Valley. Our run is just before their 2013 open cockpit celebration and you may be able to not only meet the A/C crews but also enjoy seeing many aspects of these machines which are not normally viewed by the daily public as they get ready for this very crowded and busy show.

At 0930 Sharp we will leave and travel on E120, merge on H99 and travel South to Atwater. Arriving, we will stop for Brunch in Winton on N.
