Rolf S. Johnsen 1951 – 2014

Rolf Johnsen, a ZONC member who served for many years on our Executive Committee, passed away on June 13, 2014 in Modesto, CA.

Rolf had been in ill health for a short while and only recently found out that he had terminal lung cancer. Rolf bravely faced his future, kept his good spirits and was honored to receive several retirement awards just the day before his passing.

Rolf's life was dedicated to serving our country. He served in the United States Marines during the Viet Nam war and helped evacuate Americans during the fall of Saigon in 1975. Once out of the service, Rolf began working for defense contractor Lockheed Martin Missiles & Space and later worked for over 40 years as a Technical Management specialist in quality control for the Defense Contract Management Agency of the Department of Defense.

A motorcycle rider in his early years, Rolf loved his pearl white 350Z and worked hard to bring members to ZONC from the North Valley area. He was always doing something with his car and proudly showed off his engine bay at our events. He is credited for getting Central Valley Nissan's sponsorship for our car shows for several years as well as organizing the Castle Air Museum and the Cheese & Apple Pie runs. Rolf participated in almost all of our events until this year. He regularly attended our Board meetings, always volunteered to help out when needed and took many pictures for our website and ZNews. His dedication and enthusiasm will always be missed.

Services were held at the Neptune Society in Modesto on June 16. In addition to his family, many friends also attended including ZONC members David and Veronica Morse, Ann Devor and Paul Gommel.

Also on the cover was an article about a MONO LAKE/ MAMMOTH MTN. RUN for two days with an over night stay at the Shilo Inn.

An article inside had a TECHTIP for an extra gear for your 240Z, and was reprinted from a ROAD & TRACK article.

A flyer invited member to a S.F. Giants baseball game and tailgate party.

There was a large article with pictures called Z GREAT CALISTOGA FUN RUN. The run started from the Nut Tree Restaurant in Vacaville and then went to Lake Berryessa and then Middletown, before ending up in Calistoga at the Napa Creek Winery.

An article called RACE DAYZ AT LAGUNA talked about the June SCCA races at LAGUNA SECA. They got some rain, but still had a good time and signed up 11 prospective members.

There was a notice of a Sacramento meeting at CAMELOT AMUSEMENT PARK in Sacramento.

ZONC ANNUAL BIRTHDAY PICNIC was to be held at KENNEDY GROVE REGIONAL RECREATION AREA, located at the base of San Pablo Dam.

There was a notice that the 6TH ANNUAL NATIONAL Z-CAR CONVENTION was to be held in St. Louis, and hosted by the GATEWAY Z CLUB.

A **ZONC** Rallye Report by Sally Theroux on a May Rallye called May Flowers, reported that ZONCER John Ettare came in first in the FIRST TIMER class and most of the BEGINNER class was made up of members. Bob Jenkins took first place in the EXPERT CLASS.

Rick Cassell was listed as **ZONC** President, Carolyn Dudley was Vice President, Paul Carrol was Secretary, and Heather Ippoliti was Treasurer.

4th Annual Castle Air Museum Run

By 1972 the Vietnam War was being fought to a standstill between the U.S. and North Vietnam. In late December, America's B-52 strategic bombers were called upon to lead a nine-day offensive campaign over Hanoi to force the Vietnamese back to the negotiation table. Many historians credit the might of the B-52 during that 9-day battle with the eventual signing of the peace accords one month later.

One of those B-52's and other vintage U.S. air power (many long since retired) stand proud at the CASTLE AIR MUSEUM near Atwater, California, waiting for military aviation buffs like the 16 **ZONC** members and their guests who visited May 24.

Ken Clark hosted the 4th annual trip to CASTLE; filling in for the late Rolf Johnson who designed and inaugurated the Memorial Weekend run back in 2011. For added security, Ken enlisted his wife, Mary, to navigate. It was to be a brief 60-mile trip from





Manteca to Winton, followed by a guided tour of over 50 aircraft used in WWII, and the Korean, Vietnam and Cold Wars. .

Nine cars headed out, Google maps in hand, and only 17 simple turn and merge instructions to the destination. What could go wrong? Nothing, unless you count Mary's missing step 12, "turn right on Santa Fe Ave., Modesto."

Before anyone realized the mistake, all but one car were on their way to the foothills west of Yosemite. (Joe Armstead correctly navigated the turn.) Ken's lost souls wound past almond orchards, walnut orchards, grape vineyards and cattle pastures. Then the landscape turned to the foothills and Mary confessed she was lost.

Fortunately, Eric Lindrund came to the rescue with

his GPS. The good news—only 34 miles off course. The bad news—just 15 minutes to lunch reservation at the TEQUILLA CAFÉ in Atwater, CA. Suddenly the leisurely run became a time trial through winding, rolling, tight-turning county roads. (A bit bumpy in some places, very bumpy in others!)

Instead of arriving 30 minutes early for lunch, they were 15 minutes late. But, the service was great, and the food even better, so the group was back on schedule when departing for CASTLE.

Museum docent, Air Force Command Pilot (retired), Larry Frrice, started in the museum parking lot with war stories of the B-2 "Spirit" stealth bomber displayed there. He detailed the military campaigns of this aviation giant and every other air ship displayed in the museum. He recounted stories of military aviation heroes like General "Jimmy" Doolittle and his Doolittle Raiders who flew B-25's in WWII. He added his own stories of flying B-52's during his 21 year career through the Vietnam and Cold War. And he explained how and why the military evolved from propeller to supersonic power.

Larry introduced us to the SR71 "Blackbird" reconnaissance aircraft that in 1974 was documented flying from London to Los Angeles in less than four hours. He said the pilots wanted to guarantee a record and waited a bit too long to begin slowing down to landing speed. As a result, the sonic boom they created blew out many windows of homes in the Hollywood



Hills. "Uncle Sam wrote a few checks that day," Larry commented.

Then there was the story of the KC135 "Stratotanker" refueling crew that was told to stay clear of North Vietnamese air space because they had no defense weapons onboard. But, then a F-105 "Thunderchief" fighter jet was hit in the gas tank during a run over Hanoi. The jet didn't have enough fuel to make it back to the South China Sea, let alone its carrier. Against orders, the KC135 crew flew into North Vietnam, docked its fuel line to the fighter, and the two flew

planes flew together until they reached the coast and a rescue rendezvous point. The KC135 released the fuel boom from the fighter jet, the pilot ejected from the plane and he was safely rescued..

ZONC member, Joe Armstead, knows these stories well. He was an Air Force pilot for seven. He's flown to every continent but Antartica.









The CASTLE AIR MUSEUM visit turned into a "three-hour tour." But, this one didn't leave anyone stranded. (Bad pun.) Instead, **ZONC**'s members and guests were reminded of the challenges our military has faced in the air, and the patriots who have bested those challenges. In addition to Joe Armstead, run participants George Mattos, Dick Lawless, Paul Gommel, Eric Lundrud, Ruffin Apperson and Ken Clark all served in the military. Their presence at CASTLE was the perfect complement to this Memorial Weekend run. Thank you gentlemen and all **ZONC** military members for your service.
