20 YEARS AGO IN ZNEWS November 1994

The elections for the 1995 ZONC Officers was under way, with the members accepting their nominations for office. Paul Carroll, President, Bill Halsey, Vice President, Nancy Wong, Secretary, and Ernie Kiernan, Treasurer.

For events there was an Amador Run, an A/B CHARITY RALLYE in Fremont, a car show by Surfside Nissan in Oceanside, a dual autocross event at the Oakland Coliseum, and ZONC's 22nd Annual Award Banquet was to be on January 21, 1995 at Spenger's, in Berkeley.

An article entitled "Wide Open Throttle!" by Competition Coordinator, Tom Lyon, talked about past events that ZONCers had run at SEARS POINT and THUNDER HILL, up coming events at SEARS POINT, THUNDER HILL, and the open road event PONY EXPRESS, in Nevada.

There was also a flyer for the 1995 NATIONAL Z-CAR CONVENTION to be held in Atlanta, Georgia.

In an "Area Coordinators" section Bill Halsey, the Alameda Coordinator, talked about his area meeting, and the good turn out from his area at the Santa Rosa Nissan Show 'N Shine.

In Executive Board Minutes, a Treasurer Report showed a balance of \$985.32, which was down from prior months, which was due to a decrease in membership renewals. There was also talk of a ZONC Cook Book, with a contest of favorite recipes to be held at the club picnic. Also a National Car Show Standard was presented, and the need to update the ZONC Discounter List.

In a membership drive article it stated that 47 members had joined so far in 1994 and 11 had been brought in by Carolyn Dudley, 6 each by Alex Roberson and Bill Halsey, 4 each by Tom Lyon and Paul Vancas, and 3 each by Rex Jennett and Paul Carroll.

In the Working for you section was Paul Carroll President, Bruce Leininger Vice President, Becky Carroll, Secretary, and Ernie Kiernan, Treasurer.


