I know this is blasphemy, but I'll tell you anyway... when I get an urge to put a few quick miles between me and my home in Vacaville, I often jump on my BMW motorcycle and head up to Lake Berryessa. There are some great winding roads, almost no bicycle traffic and several relaxing stops along the lake.

While it's usually a solo trip, I think it would be even more enjoyable to share the scenery with some friends. So, my wife, Mary, and I are organizing a run up to the lake, August 1st. Why don't you join us?

We'll meet in the Green Valley Costco parking lot at 9am, with the run beginning at 9:30. We'll head through the farms of Suisun Valley and into the Wooden Valley hills. It will take a little over an hour to reach Lake Barryessa. There's a large parking area right on the lake where we'll take a break and give everyone a chance for a bit of a walk around to see how the water shed is holding up during the drought. Even with water levels down, it's still a beautiful view.

Then we'll head west to Pope Valley and Middletown, and wind our way down Highway 29 to the Silverado Trail near Calistoga. All totaled, it's under 100 miles. We're planning

There was a flyer for the  $2^{nd}$  Annual Car Show/Membership Drive at the Serramonte Shopping Center, where 14 of the best Z cars in the club would fill the mall to promote the club.

The July personality profile showed off Howard & Mary Jane Mordell and their  $1980 \ 10^{th}$  Anniversary ZX.

In the GEE's SPOT from ZNEWS editor Ray Gee, he talked about all the work of putting out the ZNEWS from typing and editing to folding, addressing, stamping to taking to the Post Office.
