Long Ago in Z News January 1974

On the front page were articles about a 2nd Annual "Membership" Tour in January that was to be short and on scenic back roads in Alameda and Contra Costa counties and end at the Tuckett Inn in Hayward.

An **Incorporation** article stated it had taken an unbelievable long time to get the job done, but the incorporation papers would finally be signed on December 16th.

A **Winners** article stated Jack and Elaine Kane who had never run a rallye, won on their first try, and the event had a checkpoint at F.A.R Performance. **ZONC** also won the club participation trophy on the rallye with 12 cars. - A **Rallye Series** article stated that the **ZONC** Steering Committee had decided that one navigational rallye a month will count in this series. All rallyes will be by SCRT and would start from the Oakland Lake Merritt. - The Bay Area Membership as of December 20 showed **ZONC** had 213 members.

On page two a bi-monthly **Steering Committee Meeting** was to be held at the Glasser's home in Novato and maps would be out soon.

A **Northern California Sports Car Council** (NCSCC) article stated that as soon as the incorporation papers were signed **ZONC** could apply for membership in the council, so members could be eligible for autocross points.

The February tour would be to the **Winchester House** in San Jose.

A **Datsun Owners Clubs Association** (DOCA) article stated that **ZONC** was joining DOCA in January and would receive the Datsunews paper quarterly and the \$1 million Lloyds of London liability coverage for all events.

There was a list of **Officers** and **Area Coordinators**, Joe Roberts was listed as **Chairman**, Sally Roberts as the **Editor** of the **ZNEWS**, **Tech Advisor** was Butch Skaar, **San Jose Area Coordinator** Jim Warych, **Marin Area Coordinator** Frank & Sloane Glasser, **Autocross Committee** Chuck Tribolet, **Rallye Committee** Rich Peterson.

Profile Bob Jenkins

I was born in Stockton, California long ago and moved to several towns before settling in Santa Rosa in 1954, were I have lived ever since,



except for three years in the US Navy in Washington D.C.

I am what they call a car guy and have been since I was a kid. In 1969 I saw my first 240Z in Road & Track and bought a new 1970 Gold 240Z, as soon as I could.

In 1974, I learned about the **240Z** Owners of Northern California (soon to become the **Z** Owners of Northern California) and joined the club, to become the 222 member to join **ZONC**.

To improve the handling I added a front spoiler, wider mag wheels, bigger sway bars, a roll bar and other than that it is pure stock.

In 1984 I married another car enthusiast, Marci Tarleton. Marci drove a 1967 Cougar, and was just finishing building a MGTD kit car. Marci was a member of Empire Sports Car Association (ESCA), our local non-mark club.

In 2003 I added a new 2003 orange 350Z, which is pure stock, to go with the 240.

I have been the Area Representative for Marin/Sonoma for many years and along with Marci have been putting out the **ZNEWS** since 2004.

I really enjoy touring and shooting pictures of cars in action and standing still.

I have also been a member of Empire Sports Car Association since 1964, and along with Marci, put out their newsletter, the Pit Stop and I shoot pictures at the club's autocrosses and tours

I have autocrossed the 240 with ESCA back in the late 1960's and early '70's, when it was my daily driver. The 350 has never been autocrossed.
