

#46 BRE 240Z Lives Again at Monterey!

Once upon a time in November, 1970, race car designer **Peter Brock** and driver John Morton put the now famous #46 BRE 240Z on the track at ROAD ATLANTA and took first place in the C Production class in the SCCA runoffs championship race, the AMERICAN ROAD RACE OF CHAMPIONS. Morton reportedly drove like a crazy man against other 240Zs in that race, including the 240Z race cars driven by the Bob Sharp and Jim Fitzgerald teams. Perhaps one of the most famous moments in 240Z history, Brock and Morton did it again in November, 1971, 14.9 seconds ahead of Bob Sharp and followed by three other 240Zs including the #3 BRE 240Z driven by Dan Parkinson. Morton's fastest lap in the 1971 race was 95.31 m.p.h. and the eternal flame of fame was lighted for Datsun's 240Z.

And then, in a matter of weeks, the #46 BRE 240Z was sold to the other BRE driver, Dan Parkinson. Parkinson

reportedly took it to Phoenix to start preparing for a west coast racing campaign when the car was totaled, the details of which are murky. And here the mystery starts because the car was not seen again for many years. In fact, most of us thought #46 was just plain gone. Replicas have come along, most notably Ron Carter's car that was assembled with some BRE race parts scavenged from other cars. Although incredibly beautiful, Carter's car is not quite the real deal.

Now the **#46 BRE 240Z** is back and **John Morton** will drive it again at this year's Monterey Motorsports Reunion in race **6A** on Saturday, **August 19**.

The story is that Parkinson finally decided to part with what was left of the car and Randy Jaffe bought it from him. Jaffe put in every part from the original car that could be found and has spent years restoring it. It was shown at the BRE 50 year reunion at the Petersen Museum in 2016, but it was not anywhere close to being race track ready. Nonetheless you couldn't miss the admiring smiles and nods from the BRE crew when they checked out the car's engine bay and beautiful body work.

ZONC's good friend and sponsor, Rob Fuller of ZCAR GARAGE has been asked to be on the pit crew for **#46** and we are hoping to get an inside glimpse of race preparation and the accompanying jitters on the 19th.

If you are interested in meeting at the race track, **please remember** to buy your special Nissan parking pass when you buy your tickets online. The deadline for all advance ticket sales is **August 14** at **www.mazdaraceway.com.**




