Datslocos Run 01-20-2018

The second half of January 2018, has brought ZONC's Northern California territory several waves of much needed rain. But, the clouds broke right on cue January 20, for Datslocos' first monthly run of the New Year.

Datslocos California Chapter is a Datsun car club based in Manteca, CA. They pay homage to older, "Bluebird" Datsun models including 510's, 521's and roadsters—all taking part in Saturday's run. Datslocos President, Geno Guillen, said these were only half of the 25 cars that toured from Lathrop, Ca, to Clayton and then around Mt. Diablo and on to Pleasanton. Along the way they were joined by a 350Z, 8 older Z models, a Toyota Corona and a Subaru STI. Geno says all manufacturers, all models are welcome on Datslocos runs.

Geno concentrates his runs on back roads, first skirting the Ag fields outside Lathrop and then navigating the rolling foothills of Mt. Diablo. Most roads were wide enough to accommodate oncoming traffic, the occasional wildlife and an over exuberant German Shephard turned "traffic cop."

The highlight of the run for this writer was, according



to Geno, "just another day living with classic Datsuns." The young owner of a Datsun B210 was struggling to keep it running. A clogged fuel tank was starving the pistons. So everyone took a break roadside just outside the Morgan Territory Regional Preserve while four "resident mechanics" went to work.

The plan was to bypass the gas tank and instead use a gas can secured inside the passenger compartment. Then, using a hose, a brake line and clamps other members were carrying in their own repair kits, a temporary bypass system was fashioned that proved adequate to get car and driver home.

Geno said similar repairs have been tackled on previous runs. "Most of us work on our own cars. So, we always carry tools and extra parts and hardware, because you never know when you might need it."

On the front page was an article inviting members to a General Membership Meeting at Marie Callender's in Pleasanton, where ZONC's Expert Rallyists Bill Jones, was going to conduct a Rallye Class and a mini rallye after the meeting. Also an article invited members to a brunch at the 94th Aero squadron at the San Jose Airport, and another article told members about an up coming tour to Bodega Bay.

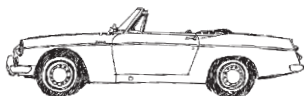
A Z Prez' 2 Cents article talked about the 20th Anniversary ZONC Awards Banquet at Travis AFB Gateway Enlisted Club, where Rex Jennett got an award for being ZONC's top recruiter with 13 new members, with Carolyn Dudley second with 12 and the Best Event for 1992 went to Paul Vancas for the Feather River Run.

There was a full-page flyer for the 29th Annual April Fools Rallye in Santa Rosa by Bob Jenkins, and another full-page flyer for the second Annual Feather River Run.

A ZONC Rallye Series article talked about the first event in the series, and there was a list of the SCCA Solo II autocross events and their locations. An article entitled Apple Farm Lunch Run talked about the ride to the Apple Farm in San Luis Obispo, written by Bruce Leininger.

There was a 2 page flyer for an event at Boreal Ridge called the Annual Sports Car Olympics, the 3 day event featured 2 Autocrosses, 2 Rallyes, a Concours, a Funkhana, and a Car Quiz, with a cost of \$95 for all the events and food.

A 2-page article called ZONC's Ano Nuevo Adventure by Sally Theroux talked about the run from Sacramento down to the Nuevo State Reserve, in San Mateo county to see the Elephant Seals. Under Working For You, Rick Cassell was listed as President, Carolyn Dudley as Vice President, Paul Carroll as Secretary, Sally Theroux as Treasurer, Sally Theroux as Z-NEWS Editor, and Carolyn Dudley as Activities Coordinator.



Super Saturday Castle Air Museum Car Show April 28, 2018

Here's a "Super 2-for-1 Event" for car lovers, no matter the make, model or year. And it comes with the added attraction of American military aviation history. It's the **Annual Super Saturday Castle Air Museum Car Show**, Saturday, **April 28**.

For one day only, this year, the **Castle Air Museum** is inviting anyone with a car, truck, boat, "rat rod" or motorcycle to display their rides alongside the museum's 65 meticulously restored aviation icons including the Boeing B-52 bomber, Bell H-13 MASH helicopter, and the General Dynamics F-16 Fighting falcon. That's right. You can show off your beauty in the shade of the Lockheed SR-71 Blackbird, a mach 3 strategic reconnaissance aircraft.

A \$40 "early entrance fee" gets you and your car on the tarmac and eligible for event awards. You will also be entered in a drawing for (2) \$100- cash drawing. After April 1, 2018, the entry fee is \$45.

Spectators will find plenty of parking near the museum and a nominal entrance fee of \$5. Normally adult admission to the museum is \$20. That's what makes this event so super—two times the viewing pleasure at less than half the price. There will be live music, food trucks and helicopter rides (\$40).
