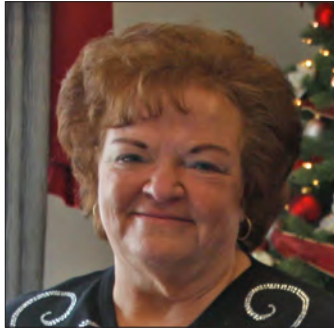

flags, and more flags. The paddock was hopping with activity as race cars went into their pits, historic car displays were built and prototype sports cars were unveiled. We returned on Wednesday to watch all the Datsun and Nissan race cars assemble on the track for the group photo. And then on Thursday, Datsun and Nissan sports cars started pouring into the corral.

Friday was the first official day of the Datsun Nissan sports car corral. Volunteers pitched in and paced out the parking areas for each model. Our feather flags were put in place and the party started. On Saturday, Peter Brock visited the corral twice and Steve Millen took a good look at the 300ZXs in the corral. Sunday was all about the parade lap and getting drivers and passengers signed up and cleared to drive on the track.

And in addition to the corral, Datsun and Nissan race cars competed in three races on the racetrack. Saturday's Group 5A race featured 13 Datsun and Nissan race cars. The race

was dominated by Porsches, landing first place and four other spots in the top ten. The only top-ten Datsun, the 1970 BRE #46CP 240Z driven by John Morton finished 8<sup>th</sup>. The next Datsun to finish, the 1971 #17 240Z driven by Larry Cooper, came in 13<sup>th</sup>, followed by the 1972 #49 240Z driven by Rob Fuller in 14<sup>th</sup> place.

Datsun 510s killed Sunday's Group 3B race with first and second place finishes and two other 510s also completing the race in the top ten. Troy Ermish out of Tracy came in first in the 1971 #9A 510 followed seven seconds later by Taz Harvey in his #51 1969 510. It's been many years since a 510 appeared at the Monterey historic races, but this year made up for lost time with a total of ten 510s putting their best stuff on the line. Roadsters were well-represented too by Mike Anderson finishing 8<sup>th</sup> in his #38 1968 Fairlady, followed in the distance by two other Fairladies and two Datsun 2000s.

Sunday's last race was a crazy quilt of race cars with two Nissan 300ZX turbos and two 240SXs competing against a first place Mazda RX-792P, five Porsche 962s and a bunch of Chevrolet, Shelby, Oldsmobile, Pontiac and Buick Trans-Am cars. Craig Bennett did the best for Nissan, placing 10<sup>th</sup> in his 1991 300ZX turbo.

Other than a few hiccups – Steve Millen getting red-flagged at the end of the morning race as he tried to join us on our parade lap, a white van parked in our corral that had to be towed, a few people who got busted by the track officials for not having parade lap passes, and others who didn't get parade lap passes because they forgot to get their insurance documents in order – the most fabulous four days at Laguna Seca went by like lightning.

We've received countless thank-you notes from our guests in the corral. Special recognition for pitching in and volunteering goes to Jason Green who opened the corral before 7 a.m. every day, Linda Williams who kept the feather flags flying, Wade Warren who made sure our finances were in order and made the event happen, Nick Fisher who contributed designs for the program, shop rags and corral

passes, Clark Fenton who paced out parking spaces in the corral and kept it organized, Susan Keller who helped us register drivers for the parade lap, Mike Keller who helped everyone with parking, Oscar Lemos who let me cut in Sunday morning at the Laguna Seca entry gate, and Paul Gommel for six months of help, ideas and support. And thank you to everyone who came to the event because without you, all of the dreams and plans could not have come true. Every time you show up, it makes the event that much better. Hope to see you again next year!
