### Datsun and Nissan Revisit IMSA at 2019 RMMR

Following on the heels of last year's fantastic ROLEX MONTEREY MOTORSPORTS REUNION, twelve Datsuns and Nissans have been chosen to compete in three races in 2019's **RMMR** at WeatherTech Laguna Seca Raceway. The 2019 **RMMR** is celebrating IMSA and will feature three classes of IMSA racecars over the four-day weekend from **August 15** through **August 18**. David Martin's 240Z, Alex McDowell's 280ZX and Rob Morgan's 280ZX will be racing on **Saturday August 17** in Race 5A (1973-1981 IMSA, GT, GTX class). Almost equally exciting will be the IMSA prototype Race 7A on Saturday where you will see advanced racing performance and styling not seen in the production-based cars.

On Sunday in Race 6B (1981-1991 IMSA GTO/GTU racecars), Craig Bennett will drive a 1991 300ZX competing against John Murray in a 1989 Nissan 240SX, Philip Mendelovitz in a 1989 240SX and Michael Parsons in his 1990 300ZX. We'll also see Datsun roadsters on Sunday in non-IMSA Race 5B featuring 1961-1966 GT cars under 2500cc including Alex McDowell's 1967 Bluebird, Phillip Mendelovitz' 1967 311 Roadster, Ross Merrill in his 1966 Fairlady Roadster and Steve Smargiasso in a 1966 Datsun 311 Roadster.

Here's what we have planned so far exclusively for Datsun and Nissan fans:

- We have a private corral with 20 reserved paved parking spaces. Datsun-Nissan race fans who wish to park
  in our Datsun-Nissan special parking area must purchase their corral passes and admission tickets only from
  ZONC. If we sell out our 20 corral spaces we will try to get more, but there is no guarantee.
   Corral passes (\$45) are good for the entire 4-day weekend.
- ZONC is again offering a discount on admission tickets.

#### 510s Rule Group 7 at Sonoma Speed Festival

Datsun 510s placed 1st, 2nd and 3rd in Group 7's Race 1 on Saturday, June 1, 2019 in the inaugural Sonoma Speed Festival at Sonoma Raceway at Sears Point. In a close repeat on Sunday, the same 510s finished 2nd, 3rd and 4th behind a 1965 Lotus. A fourth 510 also raced on Saturday, completing Race 1 with a 6th place finish. In contrast, Mercedes-AMG Petronas Motorsport brought the 10-time Grand Prix winning Formula One car championed by Lewis Hamilton to the event. This incredible race car ran exhibition laps between races and rumors quickly circulated that driver Esteban Guttieriez broke the Sonoma track record lap time with a 1:17.588 lap on Saturday morning. That's a 2.52 mile road course at an approximate average speed of 116 miles per hour including uphill Turn 2, the carousel curves, and hairpin Turns 7 at the top of the hill and Turn 11 at the bottom.

The Sonoma Speed Festival is the latest incarnation of the Sonoma Historics and Wine Country Classic races formerly held at Sears Point. Sears Point/Sonoma Raceway is celebrating its 50th anniversary of auto and motorcycle racing and has updated its historic racing event with more





contemporary race entries, special car corrals sponsored by Hagerty's and Bring-A-Trailer, and a huge food court in the middle of the pits. The event was aimed at a larger audience featuring a wider variety of race cars including dragsters roaring up the center straightaway between races. All in all, it was a day full of fun and surprises and we hope the Sonoma Speed Festival continues to show us the best of auto racing world in the future.

This car has a 1978 280z L28 engine built by Rebello Racing out of Antioch, California in March of 2000. It's a 3 liter motor with twin downdraft 32/36 Weber carburetors. It has a 9.8 compression ratio with a 487 lift and 282 duration cam. There are 205,050 miles on the car and about 20,000 miles on the rebuilt motor. A rebuilt 5-speed transmission from a 1981 280zx was installed in 2003, also by Rebello Racing. All invoices have been kept and specifications are provided.

It's a fun car to drive with a unique paint scheme finished in 2000. It comes with a Pioneer stereo and Polk Speakers.
