In Tribute to Jim Johnson

Jim participated in many **ZONC** events. He and his 240z could be found at our car shows and on many tours.

The following Tribute to Jim was written by his wife, Carole, and we share it with her permission.



James Leslie Johnson

May 29, 1941 - March 30, 2020

Predeceased by his mother, Blanche Tenney Johnson, when Jim was only 9 years old; his father, Paul L. Johnson; his first wife, Michelle; and his mentor, Phillip Townsend.

Born and raised in Napa, Jim attended Napa High School where he made many friends who remained friends throughout his life. He loved track and cross country, archery, Sea Scouts, and DeMolay. After junior college he attended San Jose State, getting his M.S. degree in Psychology along with his MFT and Educational Psychologist certification. He worked in private practice which included helping mothers using hypnosis for labor and delivery. He loved his many years as an Educational Psychologist in the South Bay and in Sonoma County. Upon retirement, Jim kept in touch with many of his students and their parents.

Always curious, Jim loved to read and had a vast collection of the works of T.E. Lawrence, middle eastern and European history, and Winston Churchill. For many years he served as the Northern California Director of the International Churchill Society. Jim also loved his travel adventures which brought repeat visits throughout Europe, the British Isles, Greece, Morocco, Canada, Alaska and Hawaii.

Jim was happiest driving his 1972 240Z in ESCA and **ZONC** events, and welcomed the advice of his many friends in these car clubs. He also was a volunteer member of the

Patient Advisory Committee at Kaiser for several years, helping patients and health care providers to improve systems and communication.

Always in helping mode, he joined with his family, friends and neighbors in many joint home remodeling and street repair projects. He built most of his home in the Santa Cruz Mountains surrounded by 5 acres of redwoods where he raised his son, Matthew, as a single parent. Then, 21 years ago he met Carole, and moved to Sonoma County where they created an idyllic partnership, each enhancing the other's attributes, loving and learning from each other.

Loving him forever are his wife, Carole Robison, children Kevin & Catherine Robison, Matt Johnson, grandchildren, Caian & Elise Johnson, & kitties, Ella & Isabella.

A gathering for family and friends will be held when we are free to do so. Jim's wish is for all to vote and restore some sanity to our elected leadership in Washington. He worked for and supported candidates who believe in science, equality, education, social programs to benefit the underserved, and conservation of our National Parks, and wildlife.

2020 RMMR Is On!

It's been like listening to the classic rock & roll song by the Clash – "Should I stay or should I go?". Whatever you want to call it – lock down, lock up, shelter in place – there has been nothing but question marks surrounding the Monterey car week events this August. Governor Newsom has repeatedly suggested that big events like the NFL opening games will not be happening in August in California. Adding to the scheduling discomfort is the fact that Laguna Seca is under new management after ousting SCRAMP's iron grip on the famous Monterey racetrack. Nonetheless, most of the Monterey car week events are happening, at least as of April 21 when this article was written. Notably, the ROLEX MONTEREY MOTORSPORTS REUNION at WEATHERTECH RACEWAY LAGUNA SECA will run on August 13–16, 2020.

The new management is making improvements to the racetrack such as electronic flagging and also has started a new ticketing program including parade laps for car corrals.

There will be 13 race groups in the 2020 historic races including two IMSA run groups featuring cars from 1973-1981 and 1981-1991 including Datsun and Nissan race cars.

Ticketing has been simplified and will be handled solely by the racetrack. To park in the car club corrals your only option will be to buy a ticket package (\$200 for drivers, \$175 for passengers) that includes racetrack entry for all four days, parking in our exclusive Datsun-Nissan corral, a parade lap and merchandise kit.




Kyusha Festival for Japanese Classic Cars
