We had to have a negative Covid-19 test within 72 hours of landing in Sitka or else we had to go into isolation until our test result arrived. We were all good tho!

photo or pdf of your car to **arts.zccm@gmail.com** as soon as possible and no later than Oct. 30. The technical requirements for photos are:

- The picture needs to be in high resolution (6.0 megapixel or higher)
- The background needs to be in a nice setting. (No driveways, no parked in the street in front of the house, no stop signs, speed limit signs, telephone poles, in the garage, people mulling around, other cars, etc.). The Z doesn't need to be a show car, but it would be nice if the background made it think it was. Racecars are also welcome.
- Art is looking for ¾ views facing front showing the front and full side of the car)
- Make sure to leave enough background around the whole car (top, bottom, left, right) so he has room for cropping.
- It's important that you supply your name, city and state along with the year, make and model of your Z and tell him that you are a **ZONC** member.

Art cautions that he will only use the images that fit the criteria above. Don't miss this special opportunity to get your car in the book and to visit Z sports car club history.
