BCR - Breakfast Club Rally Tokyo Calling

On 3/25/22, a group from Z Car Garage met at 6AM to begin our trek to meet up with all the cars that were planning on going on the **Tokyo Calling Rally** that began at Cornerstone Sonoma. There were 200 Japanese cars registered for the event (max) and I think most of them showed up despite the forecast of rain for the day. We did have some sprinkles about 8:30am but they didn't last long, only long enough to get things wet and need an umbrella or light raincoat.

After visiting and meeting lots of people, the rally began with 'hares' taking off first, followed by the groups of 'tortoise' and slower groups. Driving mostly back roads, the drive was very pleasant and spirited at times. Alvin G. lead our group and drove a very special car that belongs to a Z Car Garage customer, a 1965 Nissan Silvia. The Silvia is a very rare car and only 554 were produced between 1965 - 1968. The Mr. "C" (stock, one owner Series 1 Z, safari gold) was driven by Jonathan Buhler (Sr. Specialist Corporate Communications at Nissan USA) who made the trip out from Nashville, and managed to drive a "D" hubcap off of the car. Luckily, we saw it fly off and he was able to recover it. We lost a couple cars on our way to Calistoga, but managed to catch up with them on Dry Creek Rd. Rob F. and Nick (photographer) drove "Mrs. Butters" (safari gold), the Series 1 shop 240Z, and Dirk drove his silver 1973 240Z with a fresh engine, Z Car Garage CV Axles and Big-Brakes. Felix drove his black 1996 Nissan 300ZX Twin Turbo, Alex drove his blue 510 Wagon (LSpowered), Robert of BaT drove the 'GimletZ' Bring a Trailer 240Z and I drove my blue and white 1972 240Z OMS Tribute Pace Car. This group of cars got a lot of 'thumbs up' during our drive throughout the day.

The middle point of the run was in Calistoga with everyone stopping for coffee, eats and a restroom break. Lots of fun visiting with everyone and seeing other car fanatics and their cars. The last leg of the rally took us to Sonoma Raceway where we would gather, use the facilities and have a bite to eat before heading back to San Jose. There were a few events happening at the raceway that people could also enjoy, like drifting and some racing on the track. After a few photo ops and stretching our legs, we were off and headed back to San Jose. We headed south on Highway 101, across

the Golden Gate Bridge, through the city on 19th Avenue and ran Highway 280 all the way down to Z Car Garage. It was a terrific day and an even more fun group of guys to run with.
