Velocity Invitational vintage racing returned to Weathertech Raceway Laguna Seca on October 14-16, 2022. Once again, the event was featured as a lifestyle event with an upscale food pavilion and a heavy emphasis on high-end motorcars such as McLaren and Lamborghini. Taking a cue from Goodwood in England, exemplary historic race cars were parked on bright green artificial turf throughout the pit area.

#### 30 Years Ago in ZNEWS December 1992

On the cover were flyers for two December charity events, one called Miles for Smiles Caravan and the other TODDLER RALLYE, both collecting toys for needy families.

A Z Prez' 2 Cents article by the **ZONC** president talked about a Castle Air Force Base Air Museum Tour and the events for December. He also reminded members to vote for **ZONC** Officers and other awards. He also stated that **ZONC** was raising its dues on January 1, 1993 to \$30 per year/\$55 for two years.

An article entitled The Apple HILL RUN – WITH A TWIST stated 16 Zs were on the run but they first went to the Placerville School to avoid any parking situations at Apple Hill and took a bus to the site.

A Christmas Brunch flyer stated the Headquarters House in Auburn would be the site and a start for a run up to the brunch would leave from Sacramento.

An article entitled "Z" BAY INVASION talked about a sailing cruise on San Francisco Bay by 26 ZONCers and 8 non-Zoncers. Some of the people came in costume and some helped hoist the sails.

An Official **ZONC** Ballot listed President Rick Cassell, Vice President Carolyn Dudley, Secretary Paul Carroll, and Treasurer Heather Ippoliti, and the Best Event for 1992 had 18 events listed.

A flyer for the 20th Anniversary **ZONC** Awards Banquet was set for Travis AFB in Fairfield, with dress Casual/Semi-Formal, and the cost was Prime Rib \$20, Cornish Game Hen \$18.

240Z and 510 and both were featured in two important race groups. Group 5, 1972-1977 IMSA GT cars, featured two 240Zs and a 260Z. Group 8, 1966-1979 under 2L TransAm, 25 Challenge, SCCA B-Sedan, C-Sedan, had an impressive field of a dozen 510s. To top it all off, celebrity racing guests Mario Andretti, John Morton and Peter Brock graciously manned an autograph table for a long line of fans.

Paul and I attended the racing festival on Saturday the 15<sup>th</sup> to see the race cars qualify and compete for pole positions. Group 5 went out for 10 laps for a total 20.3 minutes with the three Datsuns facing very tough competition from the other race cars. The results were consistent over the weekend competition with Rob Fuller (#49 240Z) finishing 6<sup>th</sup> in Sunday's final feature race behind a Porsche 911 IMSA, BMW CSL, Corvette, and two Porsche RSRs. Dave Stone (#94 260Z) finished 7<sup>th</sup> and over 5 seconds behind Fuller's #49 car. Bob Clucas (#3 240Z) apparently did not run on Sunday but had come in 16<sup>th</sup> in Saturday's qualifying race.

Group 8 was Datsun party time. 510s dominated the racing field with many familiar names and cars. Saturday afternoon's qualifying race started with a very special warm-



up lap led by honorary pace car driver John Morton in the original champion #46 510 bearing his name. While the tribute to Morton seemed to escape the track announcers, those of us in the stands rose to say thank you to one of the greatest Datsun racers of all time. Following a respectful distance behind Morton and #46 on the track, Rob Fuller had the qualifying race pole position in Tom Dockery's #72 510. Other familiar names and 510s were former Dublin Nissan





owner and **ZONC** sponsor, Taz Harvey in #80; Dave Stone in #93; Glenn Chiou in #37; Adam Carolla in #90; and **ZONC** supporter Gordon McCall in #66. Fuller finished first and kept the pole for the final feature race on Sunday. But in an upset, Jim Froula in the #88 BMW 2002 is reported to have won Sunday's race by a mere 0.132 seconds. Taking second place, Fuller still recorded the fastest lap time of 1:44.035.

Mario Andretti, 82, took a McLaren Formula 1 car out for some fast laps on the track, handling it as though he was still in his prime. (Maybe he is!) Later in the afternoon, Andretti joined Datsun megastars John Morton and Peter Brock to sign autographs on posters, t-shirts, and you-name-it. And for **ZONC** member, Andrea Ivan, Sunday was the day her dreams came true when she had a chance to meet Andretti who had long been her racing idol, and to tell him about her ZMario 300ZX and Mario Jr. Fiat.







Velocity Invitational 2022 lived up to expectations after a fabulously impressive Laguna Seca debut in 2021. This racing event has everything one could hope for, and we will not hesitate to go again next year. Of course, any time there are Datsuns on the racetrack, it's a guaranteed good time for all!
