In the Rear View Mirror March 1979

The front page had news that Mary Greenhut was to be **ZONC**'s new Autocross Chairman, **ZONC** Club Jackets were available for \$15, and in RALLYE NOTES Bill Jonesi talked about a timed rallye in Los Altos hills and Portola Valley, which had at least 4 **ZONC** cars run.

Inside a Perotti Point Winner was a listing of the number of points each member had collected by attending **ZONC** events and activities.

Z PREZ SEZ article talked about the annual banquet and thanked all the dealerships and parts houses who had donated door prizes.

The editor, Mike Martin, talked about his first issue of **ZNEWS** (20 pages) which he put together, then took to a printer, then brought home and folded and stapled and took to the post office to get sent out 3rd Class.

Byron Cole **ZONC**s Rallye Chairman talked about a Pan-AM Rallye School, timed rallies, **ZONC**s Variety Rallye Series, and the April Rallye that was to be an April Fools Rallye by Bob Jenkins.

Mary Greenhut talked about the **ZONC** Autocross Class Structure, with Race and Stock Tires, and Stock and Modified engines.

ZONC Treasurer Brian Holecheck in a "Where Does It Go \$" article showed with pie charts where the club money went, with the two biggest, non-competitive events 40% and the newsletter 30%.

There was a full-page flyer for a tour to Drakes Beach, and one for a Z Corral and Parade Lap at Laguna Seca, and two page flyer for a Pan AM Style Rallye starting from Santa Clara. ZONCs membership was 463 members and 88
