



### Hillsborough Concours d'Elegance June 25, 2023

What an event to remember! For 67 years, the **Hillsborough Concours d'Elegance** has been the longest continually running Concours in the world, honoring and celebrating the excellence in automotive design and engineering.

With a little push from Bob Russell, I registered my 1972 240Z Tribute Pace Car for the event. After waiting patiently, I finally got the email that said my car was accepted, now the cleaning really began to be sure it would present well enough to *possibly* win an award since I checked the box to have the car judged.

Driving up to the Crystal Springs Golf Course in Burlingame, the fog was hanging in over the hill making it a little cooler and misty for the beginning of the event. When I arrived everyone was busy wiping their cars down to keep them as dry as possible, till the judging began. The clouds/fog eventually made way for the sunshine to come through and warm us up a bit. We had a great area to park that directly across from where all the cars entered the 18<sup>th</sup> fairway to be directed to their specific parking area.

participate in the judging. John Baker had his 1969 red 2000 Roadster, Joey Bautista had his blue 1971 240Z and I had my 1972 240Z Tribute Pace Car.

We had 4 judges that were carefully going over each and every car, looking for details that would take points away from (or add to) the beginning 100 points. Each judge had specific area that they judged, (exterior, interior, engine bay and overall car). They check to see that all the lights, turn signals, head lights, brake lights, and backup lights are functioning. One of the judges even asked if the clock worked and came back a few minutes later to be sure it did. (Yes, it works but doesn't always keep accurate time, but that didn't matter). I hadn't checked the spare tire but was lucky enough to have air in it when they checked it. When I mentioned that there were 2 photo albums with provenance about the car that they were welcome to look at, one of the judges smiled and kindly said to me, "Linda, those are referred to as the "Judges Books". I learned something that day!! They seemed very impressed with all the documentation, especially the actual program from the "California 500 Race" that the 50 tribute cars were part of.

John's Roadster was almost perfect and did win  $1^{st}$  in the "J" Class (Japanese Cars). My car came in  $2^{nd}$ , (much to my surprise) and a Toyota 800 came in  $3^{rd}$ , and it was a very cool car to see. I don't have the judging tally numbers for any of the winning cars, but it was a little nerve-racking to have them go over everything so closely.

Entering a concours event is always nerve racking because the competition is so high, but just being accepted was good enough for me. If you have the opportunity to attend one of these events, you should go! The cars are spectacular and the venue is outstanding too.
