



The early Years 1973 -1987

1973 240Z Owners of Northern California, President Joe Roberts, 201 members. Events: tours to Mt. Diablo, Wine Country, Russian River Picnic, Yosemite, Jamestown Train, and Felton. Club incorporation papers filed. Dues go to \$10.

1974 240Z Owners of Northern California, President Joe Roberts / Mike Lawrence, 301 members. Club becomes officially incorporated. Napa/ Solano region disbands and rejoins Bay region. Events: Bondurant School of High Performance Driving, tours to Winchester House, Russian River, Mother Lode, Drake's Beach and Wine Country.

1975 Z Owners of Northern California, President Mike Lawrence / Jack Kane, 530 members. Very first Annual Awards Banquet / Club's name is now Z Owners of Northern California, Inc. Events: Bondurant School, tours to Drake's Beach, Monterey, Mt. Madonna, Micke Grove Picnic, and Yosemite.

1976 ZONC, Inc, President Jack Kane, 565 members. Club bylaws and constitution written. Events: Tahoe ski, Drake's Beach, Jamestown, Sierra camping, Yosemite, Marine World, Wine Tour.

1977 ZONC, Inc, President Jack Kane, 628 members. 86 Z's participate in the ever popular outing to Drake's Beach. 18 Z's get ticketed on the way to Disneyland. Events: Drake's Beach, Get Acquainted Tour, Mother Lode, Laguna Seca Z Corral, Big Sur overnight, ZONC It To 'Em Autocross, Wine Tour, Reno.

1978 ZONC, Inc., President Dick Squire,531 members and 101 Associates. 120 people at the Annual Awards Banquet. 125 attend club Birthday Picnic. Events: Earthquake Tour, Drake's Beach, Hearst Castle, Grand Prix, Skunk Train, Wineries.

1979 ZONC Inc., President Jim Warych, 517 members and 102 associates. The gas crisis keeps tours close to home. The President totals out his brand new 280ZX on a tour. Dues

are \$15. Events: Devilish Trek to Mt. Diablo, Lake Don Pedro campout, 45 Z's do parade laps at Laguna Seca, Berkeley Tech Clinic, Drake's Beach, Brannon Island, Wine Tour.

1980 ZONC Inc., President Jim Warych, 486 members and 102 associates. ZONC holds the first membership drive with gas prizes at the end of year. Bob Bondurant speaks at a membership meeting. 68 Z's participate in the popular Drake's Beach outing. Events: Drake's Beach, Great America, First Semi Dry Canoe Trip (3 days), Pot Luck Party, Water Slide, Lake Don Pedro.

1981 ZONC Inc., President Jim Warych, 478 members and 99 associates. The 280ZX Turbo is introduced and ZONC President is invited to be one of the first to drive it at Sears Point. Events: Rookie Rallye, Z Corral at Laguna Seca, Drake's Beach, Autocross School, Reno overnighter, Sonoma Wine Tour, Lake Oroville, Z Corral at Sears Point, Disneyland.

1982 ZONC, Inc., President Jim Warych, 526 members and 92 associates. ZONC goes all the way to Las Vegas for the F1 Gran Prix at Caesar's Palace. Other events, Drake's Beach, Z Corral at Laguna Seca, Hearst Castle, and Death Valley campout.

1983 ZONC Inc., President Ron Willis, 530 members and 97 associates. ZONCers hike up Half Dome. Pregnant ZONCer goes into labor during Oregon Tour. Over 150 at Birthday Party & Picnic. Events: Malibu Gran Prix, Great America, Sears Point Corral, Oregon Caves & Crater Lake, Alameda Water Slide, and Alcatraz.

1984 ZONC Inc., President Bob Topper, 505 members and 78 associates. Santa Ana's Group Z and ZONC get together over 100 Z's at Hearst Castle. Sacramento region is re-started. Events: Drakes Beach, Corral at Laguna Seca, Mammoth Lakes, Mall Shows.

1985 ZONC Inc., President Bob Topper, 395 members and 62 associates. First April Fools issue with cover entirely written in Japanese! Events: Hearst Castle, Mammoth Lakes, Concord Car Show Mt. Madonna, Tahoe and Disneyland.

1986 ZONC Inc., President Ray Gee, 317 members and 65 associates. 50 get wet on rafting trip. Most expensive proposed tour to Mardia Gras in New Orleans, \$1,086! First Hot Line set up. Events: Monterey Aquarium, Bowlathon, Raft Trip, Swap Meet, Yosemite.

ZONC in great financial condition - \$4,160 in treasury as of Oct. Sacramento area grows to over 50 members. Events: Malibu Gran Prix, River Boat Luncheon Cruise, Tent & Train Tour, ZONC It To 'Em Autocross, Apple Hill, Christmas Brunch, ROBCP Gimmick Rallye, and Airplane Tour.
